Snow and Ice Policy

During periods of snowfall or where the external temperature drops below freezing, the Halls will ensure that the area surrounding the main entrances of the Intercollegiate Halls, and all fire exits are free of snow and ice, and gritted with salt to reduce the risk of slips trips and falls. Each Hall has an individual gritting plan.

The areas will be cleared and gritted at 8am, and then monitored throughout the day at 2 hour intervals. Any subsequent clearances will be as and when required.

All clearances and checks will be noted and signed by the relevant member of staff.

It is the responsibility of all staff in the Hall, regardless of service line, to identify and report areas in need of gritting/clearance. The ultimate responsibility for ensuring that this policy is adhered to falls with the Hall Managers.

International Hall, College Hall, Connaught Hall and the Gardens Halls are covered under Camden council.
